Take I-90E/I-94E
Continue onto I-90 Express E/ I-94 Express E
Merge onto I-94 E
Take exit 61B- 87th Street
Turn right onto 87th Street
Turn right onto South Western Avenue
Continue north to 80th Street
The facility is on the right side

From Northwest Suburbs

Take I-294 S
Exit U.S. 12E/U.S.-20E/W 95th Street
Turn to West 95th Street
Continue on West 95th Street to South Western Avenue
Turn left onto South Western Avenue
Continue 2 miles to 80th Street
The facility is on the right side

From South Suburbs

Take I-57 N. toward Exit 354
Take exit 354 toward Halsted St/IL-1
Merge onto West 99th Street
Turn left onto South Halsted Street
Turn left onto 87th Street
Turn right onto South Western Avenue
Continue north to 80th Street
The facility is on the right side

The infections and diseases include:

- HIV Infection and AIDS-related opportunistic infections
- HIV Pre-Exposure/Post-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP/PEP)
- Hepatitis C and Hepatitis B viral infections
- Sexually Transmitted infections (Syphilis, Gonorrhea, Herpes, Warts, Chlamydia, Pelvic Inflammatory Disease, Bacterial Vaginosis, Trichomoniasis, PID, Epididymo-Orchitis, Prostatitis etc)
- Infected wounds (including Diabetic Foot Infections, venous stasis ulcers, pressure ulcers, traumatic and surgical wounds etc.)
- Other Skin/Soft tissue/Bone & Joint infections (Cellulitis, Staph infections, Abscess, Septic arthritis, Osteomyelitis and Fungal infections)
- Respiratory tract infections (Influenza, pneumonia, Bronchitis etc)
- Ears, Nose and Throat (ENT) infections (Sinusitis, Pharyngitis)
- Urinary tract infections (UTI, Cystitis, Pyelonephritis)
